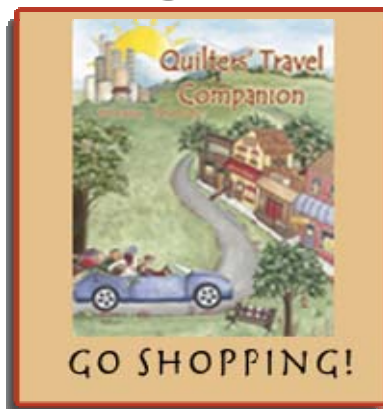

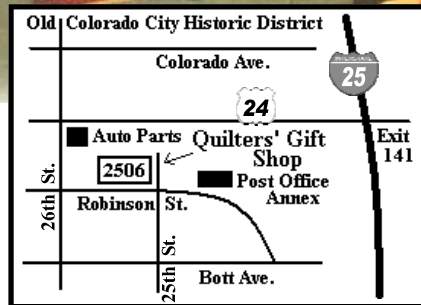

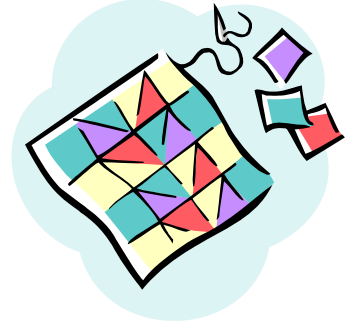

**Quilt Show Organizers**

Something new we've added to the show listings on our website. While we still list the basic information for a show for absolutely free in our book AND on our website we are now offering two other ways to promote your show. We can attach a flier to your listing for \$25. This gives folks an easy way to print out the information about your show to have with them when they're traveling. Also we offer two banner ads per state. This calls folks attention to your show first when they are looking at shows in your state. The cost of a banner ad is \$100. **Quilt Show Changes**

Please note that the shows do change quite a bit and we try to keep up with the changes via our website. Please check our website to verify any show's information you may be interested in before going to any expense to attend that show.

And as long as I'm at it, we always appreciate knowing about any new shops in your area or any that may have closed or moved.
